MATH&SCIENCE

For both math and science

- 1 pencil case for school only (stays at school) Other needed writing supplies for homework stay at home. Pencil cases do not move from home to school.

Math at school

- 1 full sized ringed binder 4 holes
- 1 pack loose leaf graph paper w 4 holes for math
- 1 30 cm ruler (possibly wood/not plastic)
- 1 10 cm ruler (possibly wood/ not plastic)
- 2 medium soft lead pencils
- Sharpener
- Eraser
- Red pens
- 1 Scientific calculator

Math at home

- 1 pack loose leaf graph paper w 4 holes for math (binder will stay at school and hw may be filed in school)
- Tracing paper (to be brought to school only upon request)
- 1 ruler at home
- 1 math set including compass and protractor (to be brought to school only upon request)
- 2 medium soft lead pencils
- Sharpener
- Eraser
- 1 calculator that can do square roots and powers
- 1 pendrive (to be brought in upon request) or access to Google drive files

Science at school

- 1 full sized ringed binder 4 holes (binder will stay in school)
- 1 pack loose leaf lined paper w 4 holes
- Pencil colors
- Blue/black pens
- 1 A4 sized folder with elastic for tests and handouts

Science at school

- 1 pack loose leaf lined paper w 4 holes (binder will stay at school and homework may be filed in school)
- 1 A4 sized folder with elastic for science fair (to be brought at school upon request) Writing supplies and pencil colors for homework to be kept at home

ART

These items can all be bought at a Cartoleria

- Sketch book – This should be hardback, with a paper thickness of 160-200g/m² and A4 size
- 2 pencils as a minimum are required: one should be lighter (HB), the other darker (4B) (this number is usually written on the side of a pencil)
- Charcoal – one should be in the form of a pencil, the other in the form of a stick.
- Water colours + paintbrushes of varying size, (it is better to have 3 decent [small, medium, large] brushes than lots of poor-quality brushes)
- Supply of personal newspaper – to keep desk clean
- Fine black pen for outlining
- Coloured pens
- Rubber
- Sharpener
- 30cm ruler
- Glue Stick
- Wipes to wipe hands and keep desk clean, which should be bought again if they run out.

Students should not bring all these materials into school to avoid cross contamination and cluttering of the classroom and desk. On the first day students should bring:

- Sketchbook
- Pencils
- Coloured pens
- Fine black pen
- Rubber
- Sharpener
- Wipes
- Ruler
- Glue stick
- Wipes
